The Grand Jury of the County of Albany, New York, by this Indictment accuses the defendant of the following crime :

FIRST COUNT:

Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree, in violation of §145.10 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, a Class D Felony, in that the defendant, on or about the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1998, at approximately 5:45 AM, at The New York State Court of Appeals, 27 Eagle Street, in the City of Albany, County of Albany, State of New York, did with intent to damage the property of another person, and having no right to do so nor any reasonable ground to believe that he has such right, damage property of another person in an amount exceeding One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), to wit: at the aforesaid date, time and place, the defendant did damage property owned by the State of New York, consisting of a building and one cloth tapestry, by means of spraying a substance on the exterior of the building and the tapestry, the defendant having no right to do so nor any reasonable ground to believe that such right existed. The cost of the damage caused by defendant to said property was in excess of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00).
