1 THE COURT: Well, there are a number of petitions
2 before the Court that need to be addressed today.
3 We'll go through them one at a time. However, I
4 would like to state for the record that among the
5 allegations being made in these papers are personal
6 attacks that Mr. Collins has made on myself and
7 Hearing Examiner Warner, which is unfortunate but I
8 assume is a result of the extreme frustration and
9 anger Mr. Collins has felt and experienced over the
10 last couple of years, and probably understandable.
11 However, he should be assured no special treatment
12 or consideration has been given to this file, no
13 action has been taken or withheld to assist or harm
14 Mr. or Mrs. Collins, and that this case has been
15 handled in this case no differently than any other.
16 No special consideration was given to any party or
17 to any consideration. The Court realizes that Mr.
18 Collins has remedies he can follow if he feels some
19 prejudice is being rendered to his detriment and he
20 is encouraged to do that if he feels it necessary
21 to protect his rights.

22 Among the petitions that need to be heard are
23 a petition filed May 27th by Mrs. Collins which was
24 heard by the Hearing Examiner in Schenectady this
