Please find enclosed Amended Answer to Affidavit in
Opposition dated January 14, 1991.

As you will notice Judge James was without jurisdiction to
sign the Order to Show Cause against me and therefore it
is null and void.

Since Judge James lacked jurisdiction to sign the Order to
Show Cause, therefore he is without judicial immunity, I
believe he can now be called as a witness to testify to
his motive in signing the Order to Show Cause.

You will also notice that since July 30, 1990, Judge Austin,
is no longer entitled to judicial immunity.

As per the letter to Judge Plumadore, This proceeding is
designed to give Arlene Carella an advantage in that
proceeding. I would ask that you prepare papers for a
preliminary injunction or a temporary restraining order
under CPLR 6301 because of the valid Court of Claims suit
against Judge Austin and his fellow family court judges.

I would like to set up an appointment with you, in order to
discuss how we proceed for here and what was discussed at
the meeting you had with Judge Austin yesterday.

If you would advise me of a time, I am available at your
convenience.
