The State Commission on Judicial Conduct has reviewed your letter of complaint dated February 15, 1989. The Commission has asked me to advise you that it has dismissed the complaint.

Upon careful consideration, the Commission concluded that there was no indication of judicial misconduct upon which to base an investigation of the judges. The Commission is not a court of law and does not have appellate authority to review the merits of matters within a judge's discretion, such as the rulings and decision in a particular case.
