ORDERED, that no person or agency shall reveal to any person or agency any information or data disclosed to the Warren County Family Court pursuant to this order, and that the information provided pursuant to this order is CONFIDENTIAL FOR USE BY THE COURT ONLY, and disclosure of the information to any third party or agency will be a violation of an Order of this Court; and it is further

ORDERED, that information furnished pursuant to this order shall be sent to the undersigned in care of Warren County Family Court, Municipal Center, Lake George, New York 12845, as he has been assigned to hear this matter.
