Today's date interviewed Susan Janczak, Clerk of The Saratoga County Family Court. Janczak was familiar with Collins and his protracted Family Court dispute and after being informed of the letter Collins sent she indicated that she would notify the Judges and Family Court personell.

Recieved a call from deputy Waring of the Saratoga County Sheriff's Department. Waring was calling to obtain whatever information he could on Collins as the Sheriff's Department is responsible for security in Family Court. Waring was briefed and a copy of the warrant, and letter were faxed to him. Waring also states that there is an outstanding Family Court warrant for failure to pay child support on Collins as well. Recieved a call from Saratoga Springs PD Officer Valente. Valente stated that Saratoga County Family Court Judge James lives in the City of Saratoga and called the police department asking for extra patrols around his residence due to Collins letter. Valente was briefed on Collins and copies of the warrant and letter were faxed to the Police Department.

5:00pm - Photo's of Collins were obtained from SA Clancy Albany FBI and copies were distributed to patrols, roll call, and Post 837. Copies were also made and sent to the Saratoga County Sheriff's Department, The Saratoga Springs Police Department, anf the State Police Governor's Detail.
